**How to Apply:**

Applicants should complete the following application and mail **2 copies** to the above address with:

- two resumes
- two photos
- two copies of the essay responses
- \$30 (non-refundable) application fee made payable to *Skidmore College*

Please do not send additional supplemental materials. The application deadline is March 31, 2007 (*applications postmarked March 31, 2007 will be accepted*). Applicants will be notified of acceptance by May 1, 2007.

Please respond to the following 6 questions on a separate sheet of paper:

- 1) Have you previously applied to the SITI Summer Theater Workshop?
- 2) Why are you applying to the SITI program as opposed to any other theater training program?
- 3) Describe your experience and training up until now.
- 4) Describe your future.
- 5) What and who have been important sources of inspiration for your work?
- 6) SITI's training is rigorous and physically challenging. All students are expected to fully participate and perform in all classes and rehearsals (7 days a week). Is there anything regarding your health or physical condition that would prevent you from fully participating in the workshop?

**International Students:**

In accordance with U.S. Federal regulations, all non-U.S. Citizens must have a student visa to study in the United States. If you are an international student applying to the summer workshop, please download the appropriate information and forms found on our website.

**Tuition and Fees:**

Tuition for the three-week workshop is \$1,550; undergraduate credit is optional and available at no extra charge. The workshop can be taken for three semester hours of graduate-level credit for \$1,900. Room and board is available on the Skidmore campus for \$1,316. Students from the local area are welcome to commute.

## **Scholarship Information:**

The Summer Theater Workshop has a small number of scholarships for students with promise who might not otherwise be able to attend the Workshop. Approximately 6 scholarships averaging \$500 each will be awarded in the form of tuition remission. To apply for a scholarship, please send the following with your application materials:

-A letter requesting scholarship assistance. Please describe your financial situation and note any unusual family circumstance or other facts you want us to consider. Estimate the amount of time and money you spent on your training and career in the last year. Tell us the amount of money you are requesting for this workshop.

-A copy of pages 1 and 2 of your most recent federal tax return or a copy of your parents/guardian's tax return if you are a dependent. This information must be provided unless you are an international student. If you are an international student, please tell us your country of origin and provide proof of your annual income.

All scholarship applications will be considered on an individual basis. Requests for financial aid will not affect admission decisions.
